Pursuant to a request by the parties, the discovery and pre-trial bellwether deadlines provided for in Case Management Order Number 54 (CMO 54) are stayed for 60 days. The Court's decision to stay CMO 54 is subject to the following exceptions (i.e. does not apply to the following): (1) third-party subpoenas that have already been served and (2) the parties' obligations to serve plaintiff or defense fact sheets. Further, the deadlines provided in section C of CMO 54 shall remain in place (i.e. if the bellwether process is resumed the first trial will begin on April 30, 2012 with deposition designations due to the Court no later than March 30, 2012).
