Reminders

Plaintiff Fact Sheet Responsive Pleading Deadline (Section E of Case Management Order Number 12 (“CMO 12”))

- Pursuant to Section E of CMO 12, If Defendants have not received a completed Plaintiff Fact Sheet (“PFS”) within 21 days after serving a Plaintiff with a 20-day notice of overdue discovery, Defendants may move the Court for an Order dismissing the Complaint without prejudice. Section E of CMO 12 **Plaintiff is given 14 days from the date of Defendants’ motion to file a response** either certifying that the Plaintiff has served upon Defendants and Defendants have received a completed PFS, and attaching appropriate documentation of receipt or an opposition to Defendants’ motion. **The 14-day deadline controls regardless of any response date automatically generated by CM/ECF.** The deadlines provided by CM/ECF are generated automatically based on the generic responsive pleading times allowed under the rules and do not consider special circumstances (such as court orders specific to a particular case or issue). When deadlines provided by CM/ECF conflict with orders of this Court (such as the 14-day deadline provided for in Section E of CMO 12), the Court ordered deadline will always control.

- **Effective July 1, 2011, the entity known as Bayer Schering Pharma AG is now Known as Bayer Pharma AG. In all future filings, documents, or proceedings related to this MDL, the parties are encouraged to refer to this entity as Bayer Pharma AG. However,**

absent an express statement to the contrary, any future reference to Bayer Schering Pharma AG will be deemed a reference to Bayer Pharma AG.
