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Court met with lead and liaison counsel prior to the hearing today.

Michael Burg updated the Court on the Gallbladder Resolution Program. The Garretson Group has submitted their report to the Plaintiffs. Everyone is continuing to push forward and hoping that all lien resolutions are taken care of by June.

Mr. Burg informs the court that in regards to generic fact discovery against Bayer, five depositions have been taken and there will be one more taken in two weeks. All parties are moving forward pursuant to the Court's order.

Kaspar Stoffelmayer spoke to the Court about CMO 68 and 70. Things are progressing smoothly. Mr. Stoffelmayer also reports that non-viable cases are moving expeditiously and all deadlines in CMO 70 for the non-viable cases will be met.

Mr. Burg reports that VTE cases are continuing to settle. There are meetings set in March and April and most cases are resolved. The Court reminds everyone with cases in the MDL to check their inventory so that we can get as many cases resolved as possible.
