- The above listed transactions require a payment be paid on-line on the same day that the transaction is docketed.
- Acceptable Credit Cards: VISA, MasterCard, Am Ex, and Discover.

Pay.gov Information

- Pay.gov allows the filer to indicate an e-mail address for the receipt. This address does not need to be the same as the filer. The address field is an optional field. Any changes made on the pay.gov screens will not be applied to your CM/ECF person screens.
- Users must check the box located on Screen 2 of the pay.gov module authorizing the charge to the credit card before the transaction will proceed.
- Do not click on the Back button while in the pay.gov transaction screens.
- All requests for refunds must be in the form of motion (see Administrative Order # 116)
