PUBLIC NOTICE FOR REAPPOINTMENT OF INCUMBENT MAGISTRATE JUDGE

The current term of office of United States Magistrate Judge Reona J. Daly at the United States District Court for the Southern District of Illinois is due to expire on September 8, 2024. The United States District Court is required by law to establish a panel of citizens to consider the reappointment of the magistrate judge to a new eight-year term.

The duties of a magistrate judge in this Court include the following: conduct preliminary proceedings in criminal cases; preside over search warrant applications; manage dockets of the Central Violations Bureau; conduct various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from a district judge; and trial and disposition of civil cases upon consent of the litigants.

The Court invites comments from members of the bar and the public addressing whether the incumbent magistrate judge should be recommended by the panel for reappointment.
