**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 636(c)(1), in all habeas corpus cases filed under Title 28, United States Code, Sections 2241 and 2254, upon the consent of all parties to a case, the Clerk of Court shall automatically refer the case to the assigned magistrate judge for any and all proceedings, including the entry of judgment. If no magistrate judge is assigned to the case at the time all parties consent, the Clerk shall randomly assign the case to one of the district's active magistrate judges, and then refer the case to the assigned magistrate judge for any and all proceedings, including the entry of judgment.
