FIRST AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

In recognition and adoption of the Judicial Conference and Seventh Circuit Judicial Council recent policy change permitting courts to authorize live remote audio access, the Court now VACATES Administrative Order No. 349. While broadcasting, recording, televising, and photographing of court proceedings are generally prohibited, each judge in this Court may authorize live remote public audio access to civil and bankruptcy non-trial proceedings in which a witness is not testifying.
