ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

To ensure the Court's docket is handled efficiently and expeditiously as the pandemic recedes and as part of the district's ongoing effort to equalize the distribution of cases, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 137, effective May 15, 2023, the work of the Court shall be distributed as follows.

All newly filed prisoner cases (Nature of Suit Codes 540, 550, 555, and 560) shall be assigned equally to all district judges. Senior U.S. District Judge J. Phil Gilbert will be assigned newly filed prisoner cases at half the rate of the district judges (50 percent) until further Order of the Court.

Additionally, the Clerk of Court shall reassign the ten cases identified below directly as follows: the Honorable Stephen P. McGlynn shall receive three cases; the Honorable Staci M. Yandle shall receive three cases, and the undersigned shall receive four cases. All deadlines and schedules previously set shall remain in effect unless and until reset by the transferee judge.
