Notice & Consent to Magistrate Judge Jurisdiction

Notice of a magistrate judge's availability. A United States magistrate judge of this court is available to conduct all proceedings in this civil action (including a jury or nonjury trial) and to order the entry of a final judgment. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(c). A magistrate judge's final rulings may be directly appealed to the United States court of appeals like any other judgment of this court. A magistrate judge can only handle a trial or final judgment if all parties consent or agree for them to hear the case.

Consent to a magistrate judge's authority. If you consent, it means you agree to have your case heard by a magistrate judge. If you do not consent the case will be assigned (or reassigned) to a district judge. There are no consequences to consenting or not consenting. All consent forms remain sealed unless and until all parties voluntarily consent.
