ORDER: Plaintiffs' Motion to Strike Defendants' Supplemental Motion to Dismiss Public Nuisance Claims (Doc. 3908) is DENIED. It is in the Court's interest to maintain an organized docket and efficiently manage the claims in this MDL. To that end, after consulting with the Special Master, the Court informed the Special Master that Defendants could file the supplemental motion as an extension of their previous motion. It is, however, difficult for the Court to determine from the information in Defendants' Appendix which state law applies to which case. For that reason, the Court ORDERS Defendants to file a Supplemental Appendix that includes a column for the state law that applies to each case. Defendants shall file the Supplemental Appendix by April 19, 2023. Plaintiffs shall then have 30 days from the date the Supplemental Appendix is filed to file specific objections to the dismissal of the public nuisance claim(s) in any given case, specifically stating how that plaintiff has alleged interference with a public right.
